Tarentaise – a ski safari

Val d'Isere together with the other ski resorts in the Tarentaise valley offers some of the world's best skiing and a very nice after-ski and nightlife. Val d'Isere will be our base and we stay in one of our partner chalets with sauna and private chef. The first night we present the plan for the week, a plan based on the latest information regarding snow conditions. You meet the mountain guide, check the equipment and have a nice dinner together.

The first day we ski around in Val d'Isere and Tignes which got a lot of easy accessed and really good off-piste skiing. With more than 100 ski lifts linked together it will be perfect surroundings for a warm up day. If the weather is good we ski some big open fields before lunch in les Brevieres, and then if it feels good we try one or two classic couloirs in the area. On the way down, if we still got some power left, we stop at La Folie Douce for some après-ski in Saint-Tropez style.



The next day – skiing in Sainte Foy! A small village with only 2 chair lifts after each other but with some of the most fantastic ski-terrain in the valley. We make a few runs under the lift before we put the skis on our backpacks and hike up the 45 minutes to the summit of “La Foglietta” on the backside of Sainte Foy. From here we have 1900 vertical meters to ski in big bowls and chutes and it's usually no people around. Back in the chalet the sauna is hot and dinner ready.

Day three – We set off to Tignes and Grand Motte, from there we will start the Grand Tour de Tarentaise that will end up in La Plagne with skiing the North Face of Bellecotte in the end of the day. The last run is a 1700 vertical meters ski with a way down for all level of skiers.

Day four – After some big days in the mountains we stay in the Val d'Isere area and maybe we find some fresh powder in the Fornet trees or you just want to enjoy the sun on Solaise.



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Maybe you want to try speed-skiing in Les Arcs? Or bobsleigh in La Plagne?

The program for a few days or a week in the Tarantaise Valley is easy to rearrange due to weather and snow conditions. There is both big runs in open mountain and great tree skiing. With our experience and knowledge of the area we make sure you get the best available skiing each day.
